

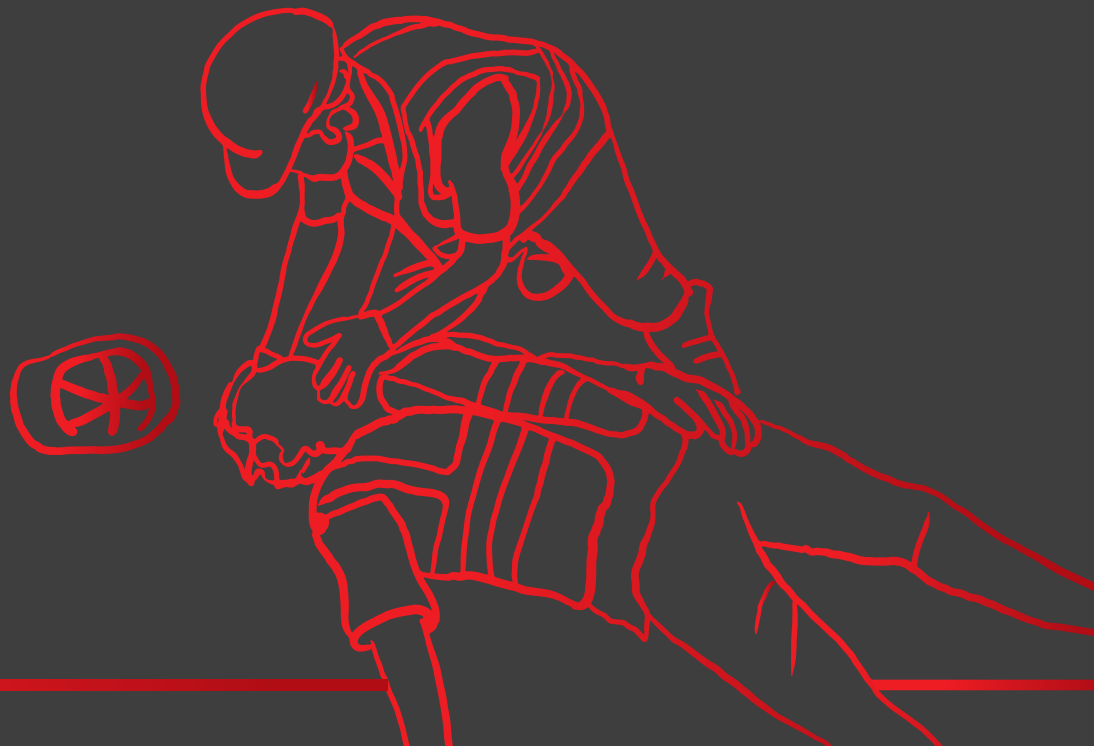

Terms of Engagement

Training Facilities

It is crucial that the client takes on the responsibility of ensuring adequate training facilities are available. This includes a room with a table, chairs, and a projector or adequate presentation equipment. In the case of Driven Machinery training, the same equipment must be made available for the duration of the training. The Learner should be made available for the entire training program.

Learners

- It is assumed that the client has ensured that the learner meets the minimum entry requirements stipulated in the Unit Standard before attending the course.
- Good timekeeping and full attendance are crucial throughout the course. Delegates must attend and complete all aspects of the course to qualify for certification.
- For delegate(s) who arrive late or are absent from all or part of the course, the full cost of the course will be charged.
- All training material and presentations are in English.
- All learners agree to the Student Code of Conduct

Documentation

On the day of training, we kindly request that the learners come prepared with the following documentation:

- **Personal Identification:** A copy of identification (e.g., ID, passport).
- **Previous Training Certificates** - Prerequisites where necessary.
- Forklift certificates are valid for two years.
- First Aid certificates must be valid if you wish to complete the next level
- **Scholastics:** Please bring relevant academic certificates to ensure assumed learning is in place.
- **Copy of CV**
- **Dangerous Goods** – Valid Licence and PrdP and Medical
- **Driven Machinery** – A valid Medical Certificate of Fitness from an Occupational Health Practitioner, including eye test
- **Working at Heights** – A valid Medical Certificate of Fitness from an Occupational Health Practitioner.

All learners who do not submit the above-mentioned documents will be required to complete a Disclaimer Letter stating that they did not submit the required documentation. Therefore, they will not be issued a training certificate and will not be endorsed by the respective SETA.

Personal Protection Equipment (PPE)

All learners must wear the appropriate PPE to participate in the practical exercises, including safety shoes, a Safety Hat, and gloves.

Certificates

Digital certificates will be issued within 21 working days from the assessment/examination date.

Certificates and carry cards are issued upon a learner being found competent and full payment received.

Cancellation

Cancellations must be made in writing if you cannot attend training. Full refunds will be issued if you give Driving Sense ten working days' notice before the start of the course. If under ten working days' notice is given, 50% of the training course fee is payable. The entire training course fee is payable if notice is given within five working days.

Branches

Driving Sense operates on a National Network. Our head office is based in Kempton Park. For convenience, we come out to the client and do training on-site at a cost of R5.20 per km.

Additional fees are charged for Training conducted on a Saturday and Sunday.
